Senior Pastor Report – December 12, 2023

The week after Council last met, Finance met to produce the draft budget for 2024. As instructed by Council, the budget is as close to 2023 as possible, with the exception of including the 3% staff raises. Your Council material will include the draft budget, which we will act on at this meeting. You'll see that this budget is only about \$6K higher than 2023, and most of that is salary increases.

The financial good news as we conclude 2023 is that giving is projected to be about where it was in 2022. Between 2020 and 2021, we saw giving drop by about \$19K; and between 2021 and 2022, giving dropped by nearly \$27K. So, giving has stabilized and over the past few months, the trend is up. However, even if we hit our projected income (as seems likely), we will still sustain a small deficit for this year. This will be the first time in many years that we've had a deficit. Because we began the year with over \$100K in the General Operating Fund, we can cover this. However, we MUST address giving in the coming year. We are certainly within reach of getting back into balanced mode, and clearly we've started the trend. But we need to do more. We can talk a bit about this on Tuesday.

One final piece of financial oversight we need to do as Council is finish the "Benevolence – Support" payments we committed to in our 2023 budget. That section of Benevolence is the 5% we divide between the Synod/ELCA, Mar-Lu Ridge and the Seminary. Since the exact number will depend upon final giving, I'll propose a percentage for each at our meeting, and we can discuss and decide on those numbers so that we can write final checks early in January.

As we move towards the end of the year, we've been having some really great Advent and pre-Christmas activities at Prince of Peace. Our Advent Evening Prayer services got off to a great start last Wednesday, and will continue through Wed, Dec 20. Also, in spite of the rain, our Church & Community Christmas program – which included our Christmas Play, Caroling and outdoor tree lighting – was a great event and well attended! Special thanks to the Conarys and their team and Pamela and the Fellowship Team for putting it all together!

We will conclude 2023 with a bang as we have special events for all the coming weekends! Next Sunday, December 17, we will officially receive some new members. On December 24, we'll hold our final Advent service at 10 am, and then celebrate Christmas Eve with two services (4 pm Children's service & 7 pm Carols & Communion); and on Christmas morning, we'll celebrate our Christmas Day service at 10 am. Finally, on December 31, we'll have a baptism! So, you'll want to be here for all of these if you're in town. And, especially if you're here for Christmas Eve and can help with worship, there is a sign-up sheet in the narthex.

There are property issues that are in process, including the bathroom renovation and the solar panels that Chuck and Laura will give up updates on at the meeting. Tom Kettler has spent a lot of time ensuring with the roofers that the leak in the BYC is finally fully patched, and he's worked with the drywallers to get the drywall repaired. So, hopefully, that part of the BYC project is now done! We are also working on the ongoing electrical problem, and hope to have that resolved soon after the new year.

Monthly Financial Summary - November 2023

Statement of Activities

Contributions

Another pretty good month revenue-wise. Total revenue for November was \$24,609 against a plan of \$25,268, a shortfall of \$658. For the second month in a row, we came close to hitting our budgeted revenue target.

Expenses

Total expenses were \$26,388 against a plan of \$26,858, under planned expenses by \$470, but also over our total revenues by \$1,778. Several notable items that drove up the expense number this month: Montgomery County Rainwater Tax - \$567; General Maintenance - \$,1800; Fellowship Discretionary - \$904. Plus, a double cleaning bill this month at \$465 X 2. On the benevolence side, there was a discretionary expenditure of \$450 to assist in Afghan Relief and the Dufief family.

Deficit

With another slight revenue shortfall, our surplus/deficit gauge moved in the wrong direction again last month. The \$9,625 deficit from the end of October increased to \$11,404 at the end of November.

Fund Balance Report

The General Operating Fund stands at \$103,841, a decrease of \$1,779 from October. The Building Fund had total receipts of \$336, no disbursements, and an ending balance of \$161,878. The Debt Reduction Fund was unchanged at \$1,000. The plan going forward in 2024 is to transfer the remaining balance to the Feast Fund and retire this fund. The Feast Fund had contributions of \$2,026, no disbursements, and an ending balance of \$35,945. Total revenues/contributions/transfers to all funds from all sources were \$28,999. All other Fund Balances are positive and in good standing.

Cash Activity Report

The adjusted beginning cash balance on November 1, 2023 was \$383,656 and the ending balance was \$383,596 as of October 31, 2023, a decrease of \$60 from the end of October 2023.
