Donations

1. Please clean/dust your donations prior to donating, if needed. Items should be in good, clean, usable condition, no rips, tears, stains and free from pet hair.

2. We do not accept:
 - Cassette tapes
 - Child car seats
 - Cookie tins
 - Cribs made before 2011, drop-side cribs
 - Desks
 - Electronics that do not turn on, or are incomplete or damaged
 - Encyclopedias
 - Entertainment centers/China cabinets
 - Exercise Equipment (heavy, such as Stationary Bikes, Treadmills, Ellipticals)
 - Fax machines
 - Fuels or chemicals of any type
 - Furniture that will not fit into a car
 - Highchairs made before June 2019
 - Hospital beds
 - Items made from particleboard
 - Large appliances
 - Magazines
 - Mattresses or box springs
 - Mobile/smart phones (but we will take accessories)
 - Non-working appliances
 - Outdated computer guides
 - Pianos & organs
 - Printers (Laser, Inkjet, Dot Matrix, and multi-function)
 - Propane bottles
 - Sofa beds
 - Standalone scanners
 - Strollers made before 2016
 - Textbooks
 - Tires
 - Travel books
 - TV's that are not flatscreen, or are bigger than 60" (no projection, consoles, or tube type)
 - Video tapes
 - Waterbeds
 - Window air conditioners

NOTE: We do not deliver items bought at the Yard Sale.

Leftovers will be picked up by Lutheran Mission Society on Monday.

3. Donations need to be delivered by Thursday to ensure that the items can be sorted and priced appropriately. Computers and electronics (not appliances) are due 2 weeks before Yard Sale.
4. Please take the items to the appropriate department area as noted on the maps posted around the church. If you need help, an assistant will be available.
5. If you need a donation receipt, you may pick one up from the credenza in the Narthex or the designated area in the BYC.
6. We take donations of clothing hangers. Deliver them to the clothing area.
7. Plastic bags, shopping bags, and boxes are gladly accepted. If you have any of these, please distribute them to the Narthex, Fellowship Hall, and the BYC.
8. Open-top boxes from Costco and Sam's for the Children's Department.
9. We accept most donated items in each department (except what is listed in item #2) provided they are in usable condition. Someone will say, "that is exactly what I need".
